ENROLL

Eligibility Requirements:

- ·Must be at least 18-years of age.
- ·Must have either a high school diploma or GED equivalent; or be co-enrolled in a GED program.
- ·Must be employed on a full-time basis by a participating employer in the Locklin Technical College Apprenticeship Program, GNJ.

There is NO COST for tuition or fees.

Textbooks for the program will be purchased by the employer.

LEARN

The Plumbing Apprenticeship Program is a combination of on-the-job training (OJT) and classroom instruction. The classroom segment meets face-to-face each Thursday from 5:30-9:00 pm at Locklin Technical College. The program prepares the individual to read blueprints and safely, correctly, and efficiently install and maintain plumbing systems. These plumbing systems include underground water supply, storm water, sewer drainage, fixture installation and waste and vent piping both inside and outside of buildings, residential and service plumbing.

EARN

A student can earn OSHA certification and NCCER Core, Plumbing Level 1, Level 2, Level 3 and Level 4 certifications. Upon completion of the apprenticeship program, apprentices are awarded an Apprenticeship Completion Certificate from the Florida Department of Education, Division of Workforce Development. These credentials are recognized and respected by the federal, state and relevant industries.
