Electrician-APPR is a 4-year, 8000-hour accredited apprenticeship program that provides a combination of on-the-job training (OJT) and related training instruction (RTI).

# ENROLL

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be at least 18-years of age.
- Must have either a high school diploma or GED equivalent; or be co-enrolled in a GED program.
- Must be employed on a full-time basis by a participating employer in the Locklin Technical College Apprenticeship Program, GNJ.

There is NO COST for tuition or fees.

Textbooks for the program will be purchased by the employer.

# LEARN

Electrician - APPR is a combination of on-the-job training (OJT) and classroom instruction. The classroom segment meets face-to-face each Thursday from 5:30-9:00 pm at Locklin Technical College. The program provides the individual with a comprehensive structured program of study, based on the Mike Holt Electrical Training Apprenticeship Curriculum, a curriculum that is focused on the National Electrical Code and Construction Safety.

# EARN

This program will prepare participants for the jobsite as well as the journeyman exam. Upon completion of the apprenticeship program, apprentices are awarded an Apprenticeship Completion Certificate from the Florida Department of Education, Division of Workforce Development. These credentials are recognized and respected by the federal, state and relevant industries.
