



Student Retention Plan

Radford M. Locklin Technical College instructors, counselors, and career specialists work collaboratively to reduce barriers to student success and completion.

Grades and attendance are monitored regularly during enrollment in the course by the instructor and student. Learning plans are adjusted as needed to support student success.

Budgetary resources include scholarships awarded to retain students when other financial sources may not be available. Students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Major activities include counseling students, scholarship opportunities and completion of the Council on Occupations Education Annual Report.

The Student Retention Plan is evaluated by the student services staff annually and is a topic of discussion with stakeholders in Occupational Advisory meetings.
